


This Month's Featured Book:

by <u>Herman Parish</u> (Author), <u>Lynne Avril</u> (Illustrator)



Amelia Bedelia's First Valentine Discussion Questions for REACH Partners

- 1. If you could give a Valentine to someone special in your life, what would it say, and why?
- 2. Amelia Bedelia is always trying her best to understand new things. Have you ever learned something new and felt a little confused but kept trying? Tell us about a time when you learned something new or tricky.
- 3. What are some different ways we can show kindness to people, just like Amelia Bedelia tried to do?
- 4. What was the funniest moment in the book for you, and why did it make you laugh?
- 5. If you were to plan the perfect Valentine's Day party, what would it look like? What games or activities would you have for your friends?

Discussion Questions for Classroom Teachers & Librarians

- 1. How do you think Amelia Bedelia feels when she misunderstands things about Valentine's Day? Can you think of a time when you misunderstood something, and what did you learn from it?
- 2. What does friendship mean to Amelia Bedelia in the story? How can we show our friends that we care?
- 3. Amelia Bedelia tries to give the best Valentine's Day cards. Why do you think it's important to give kind words or notes to others? Can you remember a time someone gave you a special card or note?
- 4. What's your favorite part of Valentine's Day? How do you like to celebrate it with your friends or family?
- 5. Why do you think Amelia Bedelia was so surprised by all the ways people celebrated Valentine's Day? How do we show love in our own family traditions?


